Persons wishing to file for the positions may pick up a petition from the School District Clerk, Terri Reinhardt, at the Broadview School Office or from the Yellowstone County Election Administrator. Petitions must be filed with the School District Clerk no later than 5:00 p.m. on **Friday, March 29, 2019**.

If you are not currently registered to vote, you can do so by contacting your county election administrator. The close of regular voter registration is **Monday, April 8, 2019**.
